In 2020, the revenue of publishing industry is EUR 561million, and there are 35,041 new titles published by 4,694 publishing houses.

Children's Books

3,937 children's books published in 2020.

11.24% of 2020 new titles are children's books.

1.29% increase in 2020 children's books published, compared to 2019.

36.47% of 2020 chidren's books are translated titles.

Comics

2,821 comic books published in 2020.

8.05% of 2020 new titles are comics.

3.03% increase in 2020 comics published, compared to 2019.

87.1% of 2020 comic books are translated titles.

Creative Content Agency) to introduce a select list of Taiwanese titles, ranging from fiction, nonfiction, children's books and comics, to foreign publishers and readers alike.



On the Books from Taiwan website you will find information about authors and books, along with who to contact in order to license translation rights. All titles featured are eligible for the **Translation Grants Program**, sponsored by the Ministry of Culture of Taiwan.



Translation Grants Program

Grant for the Publication of Taiwanese Works in Translation (GPT) is set up by The Ministry of Culture to encourage the publication of Taiwanese works in translation overseas, to raise the international visibility of Taiwanese cultural content, and to help Taiwan's publishing industry expand into non-Chinese international markets.

The so-called Taiwanese works must meet the following requirements:

- (1) Use traditional characters,
- (2) written by a natural person holding an Taiwan(R.O.C.) identity card, and
- (3) has been assigned an ISBN in Taiwan. All genres will be considered. Priority is given to projects with books that have won the Golden Tripod Award, the Golden Comic Award, or the Taiwan Literature Award.

The maximum grant available for each project is NT\$600,000, and all legally registered or incorporated foreign publishing house (legal entity) are welcome to take this opportunity. The GPT usually is open for application every twice a year (in spring and autumn). For detailed information,
