General introduction:

Around 23 million people live in Taiwan. In 2021, the publishing industry's total revenue was EUR 599million (+5.28% YoY), and 57,710 new titles were published by 4,873 publishing houses. Data show a significant increase in the number of new titles across all genres, suggesting Taiwan's publishing industry is now in recovery following the pandemic-induced downturn.

5,895 children's books published in 2021 **9.98%** of all new titles published in 2021 An increase of **1,958** titles (compared to 2020) **4.9%** are translated titles



Comics

6,164 comic books published in 2021 **10.66**% of all new titles published in 2021 An increase of **3,333** titles (compared to 2020) **42.3**% are translated titles

The e-book trend:

The growing popularity of e-books can clearly be seen in Taiwan. The growth is particularly strong in the comic book sector; according to a 2020 report by Taiwan Creative Content Agency, more than 50% of comic book reading now takes place online.
