Grant for the Publication of Taiwanese Works in Translation (GPT)

is set up by The Ministry of Culture to encourage the publication of Taiwanese works in translation overseas, to raise the international visibility of Taiwanese cultural content, and to help Taiwan's publishing industry expand into non-Chinese international markets.

The so-called Taiwanese works must meet the following requirements:

- (1) Use traditional characters;
- (2) Written by a natural person holding an R.O.C.(Taiwan) identity card;
- (3) Has been assigned an ISBN in Taiwan.

i.e., the author is a native of Taiwan, and the first 6 digits of the book's ISBN are 978-957-XXX-XXX-X, 978-986-XXX-XXX-X, or 978-626-XXX-XXX-X.

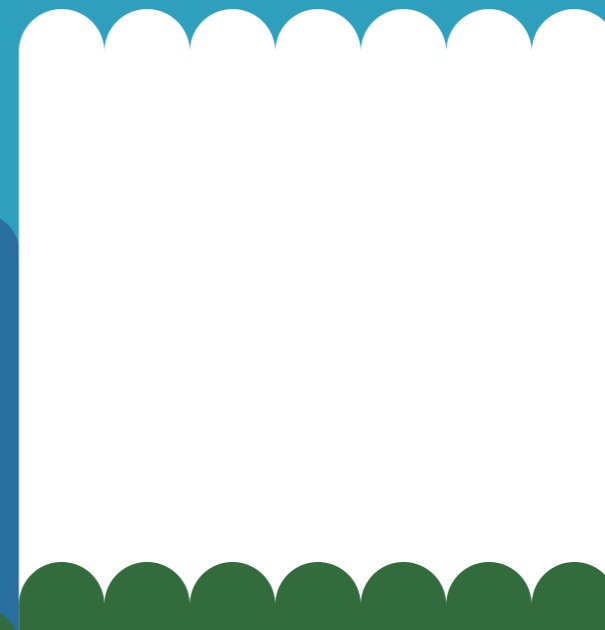
The maximum grant available for each project is NT\$600,000, and all legally registered or incorporated foreign publishing house (legal entity) are welcome to take this opportunity. The GPT usually is open for application every twice a year (in spring and autumn).

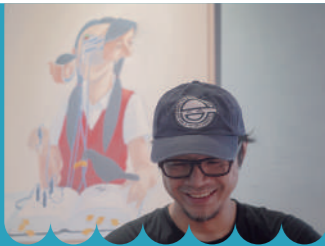

The Use of the Foreign Land, Trilogy of a Taipei Migrant 異鄉之用

This collection of fable-like stories serves as a condensed portrayal of the experiences of the author herself, a Malaysian-Chinese writer and artist, who has lived in Taipei as an outsider for twenty years. The collection includes three picture books: *Mrs. Basin*, *Forest of Breast*, and *The Hands Which Grew*. The three books are crafted in distinct styles, which, though at first glance dissimilar, resonate with the author's strong and unique essence. The artwork includes pronounced linework, using relief printing, incorporating textured single-brush prints, ink effects, multi-layered collages, and computer-aided post-production, resulting in rich and eerie visuals.

Lifetime of Love for Animals, the Documentary of Taipei Animal's Shelter 今生好好愛動物：寶島收容所採訪錄

This book begins with a tragedy, in 2016, when Zhi-Cheng Jian, director of the Animal Shelter in Taoyuan City, reportedly unable to bear the responsibility of euthanizing unwanted dogs, ended her own life at the age of 32. In order to tell this story, maniniwei conducted in-depth interviews with 8 volunteers and 4 staff members, becoming a volunteer herself. With over 150 illustrations and 90,000 words, the book portrays real situations faced by the staff, volunteers, and animals.
